Course Descriptions



Emergency First Aid & CPR

(Level A) – 6-8 Training Hours

Course Content:

CPR and breathing emergencies in adults; AED, first aid for bleeding; sudden illness and injury emergency care skills for the occupational first aid provider.

Who Would Benefit:

The general public, Canadian business, industry and government agencies with employees that have an occupational requirement to be Emergency First Aid trained.

Standard First Aid

14-16 Training Hours

Course Content:

CPR and breathing emergencies, AED; first aid for bleeding; sudden illness and injury emergency care skills for the occupational first aid provider. The program is intended to be flexible in content and offers adult only CPR or may be combined with infant and child CPR and AED skills to create the standard first aid CPR-A or CPR-C option. that are occupational required to have first aid knowledge and skills.



Emergency Medical Responder-

40 - 100 Training Hours

Course Content:

CPR and breathing emergencies in adults; advanced first aid; use of oxygen equipment; AED; primary and secondary assessment skills; first aid for bleeding; sudden illness and minor injury; return to work protocols and record keeping for the occupational healthcare provider.

CPR (Level A, B, C and Health Care Provider)

The Heartsaver Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Automated External Defibrillation (AED) course contains up-to-date content and science from the 2010 Guidelines for CPR and ECC. It is designed to teach lay rescuers the lifesaving skills of cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and relief of choking in adults, children and infants, as well as how to use an automated external defibrillator (AED) with both adults and children. The course is designed for those who have a duty to respond to a cardiac emergency because of job responsibilities or regulatory requirements.



Advanced Cardiac Life Support

14 Training Hours

ACLS is an advanced, instructor-led classroom course that highlights the importance of team management of a cardiac arrest, team dynamics and communication, systems of care and immediate post-cardiac-arrest care. Specific skills in airway management and related pharmacology are also featured. Skills are taught through discussion and group learning, while testing stations offer case-based scenarios using simulators.

Pre-Requisite is a Current Heart and Stroke BLS for Health care Provider Certification



Pediatric Advanced Life Support

14 Training Hours

PALS Provider course enables health-care professionals to develop the knowledge and skills necessary to better recognize and treat critically ill infants and children. The course materials are scenario-based, and a team approach is used to teach emergency management of pediatric patients approaching or already in respiratory or cardiac arrest, from the early minutes through patient stabilization and/or the transport phases of a pediatric emergencies

Pre-Requisite is a Current Heart and Stroke BLS for Healthcare Provider Certification

Neonatal Resuscitation Program

4 Hours Classroom 4 Hours Online Pre-course

NRP is an educational program jointly sponsored with the American Heart Association (AHA). The course has been designed to teach an evidence-based approach to resuscitation of the newborn to hospital staff who care for newborns at the time of delivery, including physicians, nurses and respiratory therapists.



International Trauma Life Support

16 Training Hours

Course Content:

ITLS Provider includes 8 hours of classroom instruction, 8 hours of hands-on skills training, and testing for ITLS Basic or Advanced certification. Innovative skills stations let you practice the abilities appropriate for your level of certification. This course is ideal for pre-hospital professionals, Registered Nurses and Physicians working in rural settings. AMS has added additional advanced trauma skills stations including chest tubes, surgical airway management, EZ I/O and rapid sequence intubation for rural health care providers
